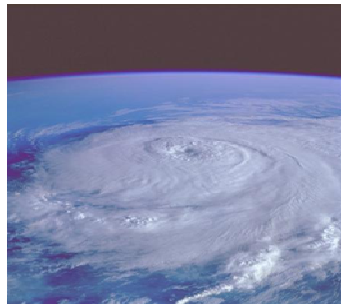


## CDM Investment Newsletter
